Participants of the Believe Achieve Inspire Leadership Program were honored to have **Founding Director of the Griffith University Islamic Research Unit** and the **Director (Qld Node) of the National Centre of Excellence of Islamic Studies Australia (NCEIS)**, Dr. Mohamad Abdalla, address them on the legacy of the Islamic Civilisation.

Dr. Abdalla’s scholarly expertise and insurmountable insight into the legacy of the great Islamic Civilisation on the socio-political and economic spheres of modernity was invaluable for BAILP participants who were privileged to have the great scholar address them on the topic.

Components covered by Dr. Abdalla in the FAMSU- organized workshop included; the impact and contributions of Islamic civilization using Science as an example; and famous contributions of Muslim scholars in the natural and social sciences and humanities.

Current BAILP participant and political science student, Tasnim Sammak said the module delivered by Dr. Abdalla was a highlight of the FAMSU stream of Islamic leadership;
